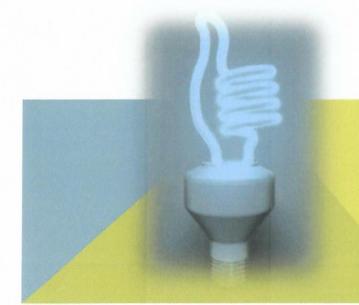

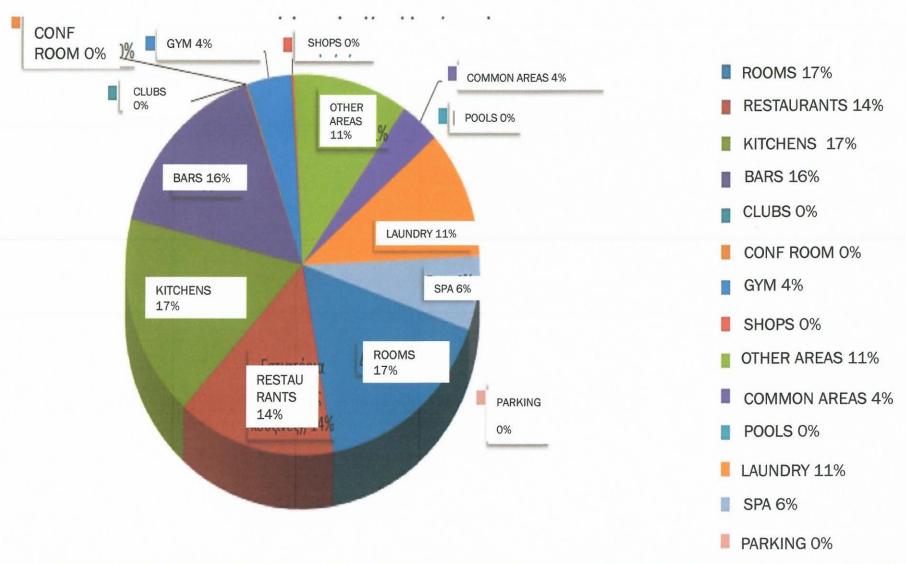

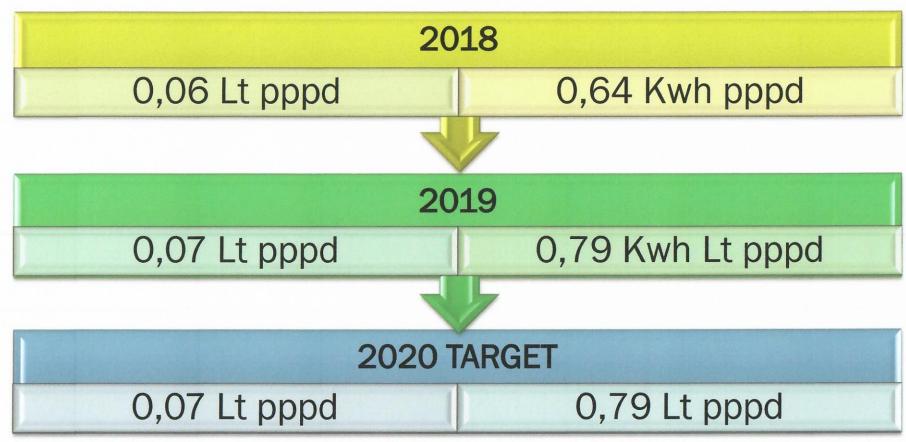


### Electricity Consumption of Machinery & Equipment





### GASOIL CONSUMPTION

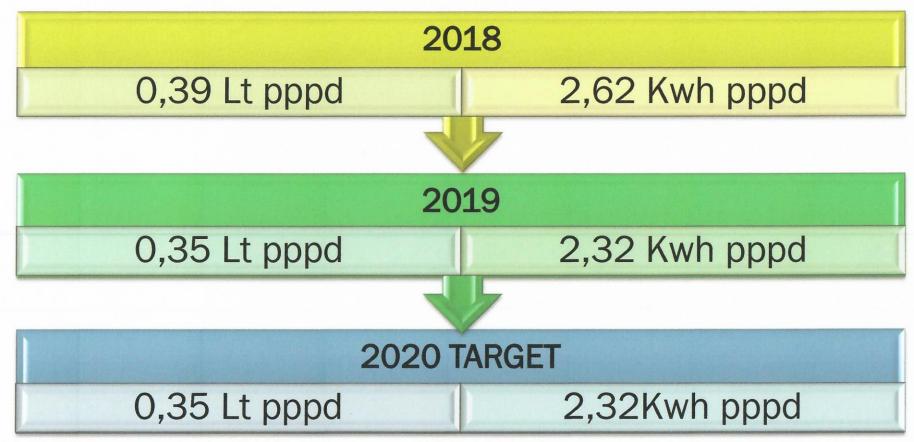




Consumption kept to minimum due also to the wide use of solar panels which reach their maximum of operation during summer

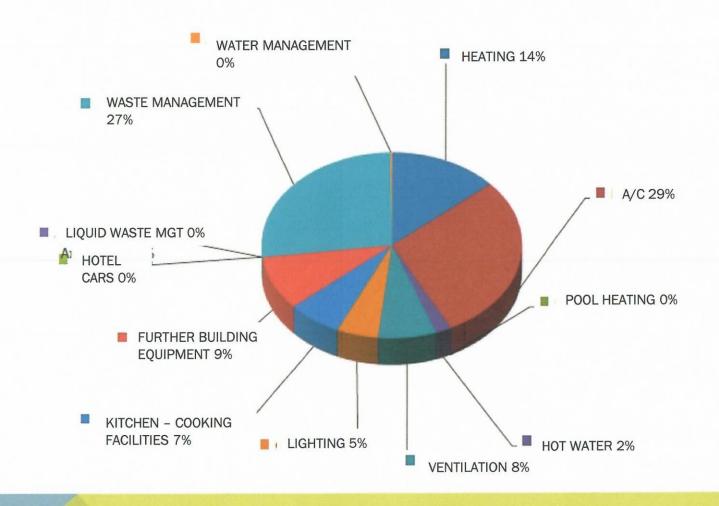
## **CO2 FOOTPRINT**

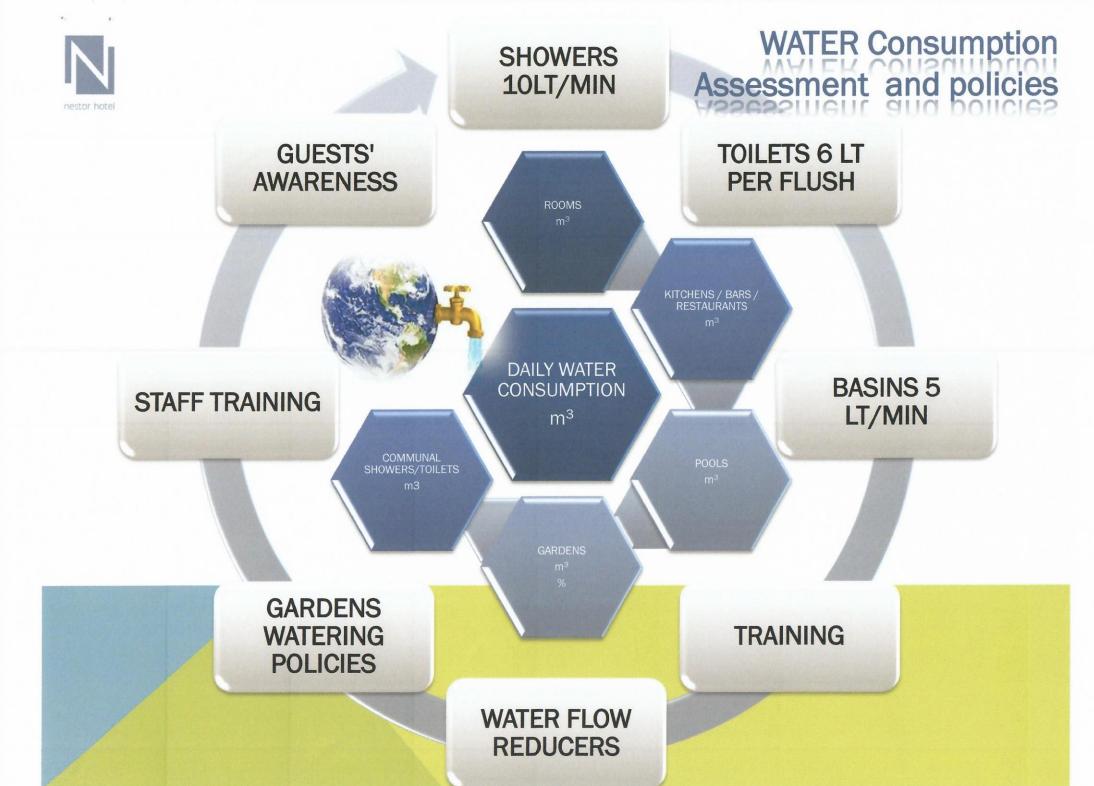

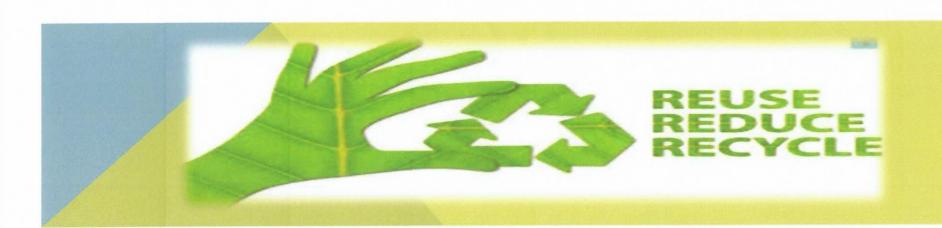

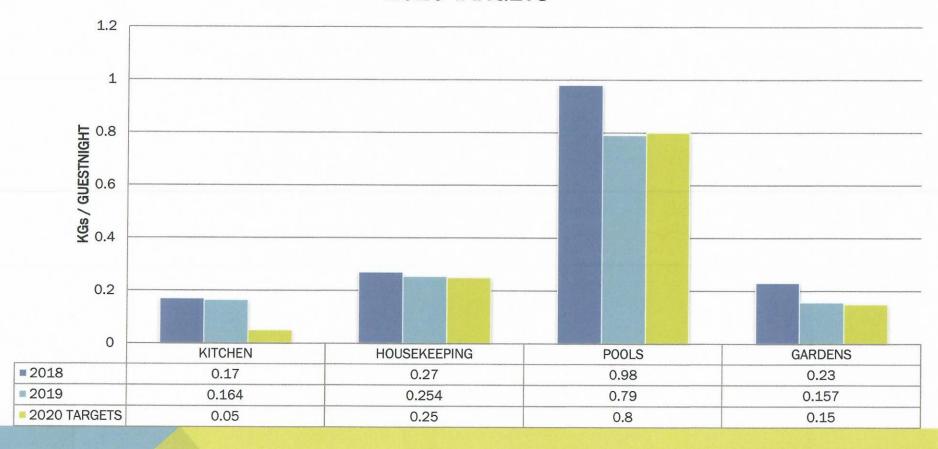

#### **Our Children's Protection Policy**



Nestor Hotel strongly believes that no child or young person should experience abuse either physical or emotional or sexual, neglect or exploitation of any kind. Thus in accordance with the UN Convention on the Rights of Children we are committed in respecting and safeguarding all children and young people under the age of 18 who stay in our property as well as those who work or live in our locality, ensuring that they are protected from all forms of abuse, exploitation or neglect.

#### We believe that:

- The welfare of children or young persons is paramount
- All children or young people under the age of 18 have a right to equal protection from abuse, neglect or exploitation, irrespective of their age, disability, gender, race, religious belief, sexual orientation or sexuality.

#### We will keep children and young people safe by:

- Valuing as well as listening to respecting them
- Training our staff on the meaning of this policy and our Safeguarding Children procedure so that they are sensitive to the signs of child abuse, neglect or exploitation and are aware of the actions they need to take to safeguard a child that they suspect may be at risk in or around our property
- Promoting our Safeguarding Policy to our suppliers, sub-contractors and guests so that they can support our commitments.
- Sharing our concerns about vulnerable children or young people with local child protection organizations and law enforcement, so that we always act in their best interests.

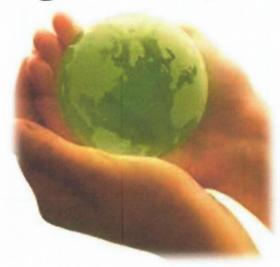
